LIFE SKETCH OF SAINT JOHN THE APOSTLE

Saint John is the younger brother of Saint James, and son of Zebedee and Salome. He was chosen as one of the twelve apostles by Jesus Christ. John is the youngest of the apostles and the most beloved one of Jesus. His mother Salome, said to be a sister of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of Jesus. John and James are the first cousins of Jesus. Once their mother requested Jesus to give her sons, the chief places in his kingdom. Jesus asked the sons, whether they could drink the cup (chalice) of suffering that he himself was about to drink. (Mt. 20:22). They replied, "we can" and Jesus said, "Very well, you shall drink my cup" (Mt. 20:23, Mk. 10:39) thus granted them the grace to suffer. The chalice St. John holds in the picture thus symbolizes his acceptance and "Yes" to Lord.

Saint John was privileged to be with Our Lord Jesus Christ at the time of, almost every important event in His life; like raising the dead to life (Mk. 5:37; Lk. 8:51), His transfiguration (Mt. 26:37; Mk. 9:2; Lk. 9:28) and the agony at Gethsemane (Mt. 26:37; Mk. 14:33), to prepare the last Supper, Present at the trial of Jesus in the high priest's palace (Jn. 18:15), at the foot of the cross throughout Christ's agony, the first one on Easter morning to reach the empty tomb. (Jn. 20:4:5). The first to recognise Jesus after his Resurrection. In his letters, John constantly emphasized :

A policy is a present decision for future action. The responsibility of effective implementation is placed on all stakeholders. This policy and its practical action, agenda, when implemented, will transform our educational institutions making them really modern and truly Indian.

SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

All Johanans are expected to conduct themselves as exemplary students at all times and in all places. The whole-hearted co-operation of the parents/guardians is expected at all times in the formation of the character of their children. As the child progresses from the lower to the upper classes, he/she will be given ample opportunities to shift from conforming to externally imposed order to self-imposed discipline.

1. The students are expected to manifest behavior befitting gentleman who are serious and decent citizens at all times. Conduct which is injurious to the moral tone of the school or the lives of others and not in accord with strict discipline, is liable to bring suspension or dismissal. This applies most especially during the class hours and on to and from the school.
2. All are sincerely exhorted to cultivate the habit of praying every morning on rising and every night before resting.
3. The School Diary should be brought to school every day.
4. All are expected to speak English in the school.
5. Th school insists on punctuality, regularity, fidelity to study and work assignment.
6. Pupils are expected to be in the school five minutes before the bell.
7. Pupil should remain silent at the bell before the assembly and after tiffin. They are allowed to move in silence only after the bell.
8. In case of late coming or absence, the students should seek the permission of the Principal to attend the classes.

9. A boy/girl who comes late to school THRICE a month will invite disciplinary actions.
10. Irregular attendance, unjustified or unexplained absence for more than two class days, habitual idleness, irregular payment of fees, disobedience or objectionable moral influence, frequent failure to obtain “good” in conduct or application in the progress report, justify dismissal.
11. If any student is irregular in paying the fee, he/she will be asked to discontinue from the school.
12. Pupils are responsible to the school authorities for their conduct both in and outside the school. Hence misbehaviour in public or streets and in conveyance, justify dismissal.
13. Running, playing or shouting inside the school building is never allowed.
14. Pupils are expected to be co-operative with their captains, leaders and monitors whom they elect to maintain the discipline and ideals of the school. During the absence of the teachers, the monitor will be responsible for the order and discipline of the class.
15. When pupils move along the corridors to change class, they must walk in silence and in single line. They should always keep to the left. The teacher in the class should be the last to leave.
16. Personal cleanliness and hygiene are expected from all. Shaggy, unkempt hair will not be permitted.
17. All should be particularly careful not to throw any papers, seeds etc. in the school premises. They should take an honest pride in keeping the school premises clean by using the dustbins for lunch scrapes, scrap paper, fruit peels, etc.
18. No chewing gum will be allowed in the classrooms or anywhere else in the school campus.
19. No collection for any purpose what so ever is to be started, and held without the prior permission of the principal.
20. Gift and presents to the members of the staff in their honour also require the prior sanction of the Principal.
21. No books other than text or library books (comics, newspaper, periodicals, etc..) or any other objects (transistors, camera, cell

phones, etc.) liable to prove a source of disturbance are not permitted to bring to the school. Students are not expected to bring valuable pens, watches, cell phone camera, money, clothes and other articles to school. The school is not responsible for any goods and valuable items lost. Money should not be lent or borrowed or articles given exchanged.

22. Each and every student should endeavour to keep up the high tone of the school by excelling in good manners. Hence, for the smooth running of the school, no students may bring to school any objects liable to prove a source of disturbance e.g. crackers, mobile or any other forbidden items, etc.
23. If any student repeatedly disobeys the Principal's order, T.C. will be issued immediately.
24. If the parent/student produces any false medical certificate, the ward will be dismissed from school.
25. Teachers of the school shall not be engaged as private tutors without consulting the Principal and his written consent is mandatory. No tuitions may be taken from a teacher who teaches the pupil's class.
26. No student may enter a classroom other than his or her own classroom without permission of the Principal/Class Teacher.
27. Any student desiring to be exempted from P.T. or Games must produce a doctor's certificate to the effect that he/she is physically unfit to take part.
28. No student should be sent to school if suffering from a contagious or infectious disease.
29. Keeping in view the safety to students and to promote discipline among the students, carrying and bursting of crackers and other dangerous materials in the school campus is strictly not permitted and the defaulters will be dismissed immediately.
30. A student who is guilty of malpractices in connection with examination or uses unfair means/receives or gives assistance in any form during a Test or an Examination or tampers with the evaluated answer papers in any way or alters marks in the Report Card, will be initiated disciplinary actions.

31. Any pupil who is persistently insubordinate or is repeatedly or wilfully mischievous or has committed an act to serious indiscipline or immorality, insubordination, contempt of authority or wilful damage to school property or who in the opinion of the Head of School, has an unwholesome influence on his fellow pupils will be expelled immediately.
32. Any student found to be involved in physical assault of other students or found to be guilty of disrupting the peaceful academic atmosphere of the school, is liable to be punished.
33. Pupils should not take part of any Political Organizations or in any political activities.
34. Heads of school shall see that the principles of discipline are properly observed. Regularity and implicit obedience should be insisted upon. Politeness and courtesy of speech and conduct as well as cleanliness of dress and person should be included.
35. The tutorial sheets or any other study materials are for the use of our students only. It shall not be redistributed, loaned or copied.
36. Pupil should realise that they are responsible to the school authorities not only for their conduct in the school but also for their general behaviour outside. Any reported or observed objectionable conduct outside the school on the part of the pupils should make them liable for disciplinary action.
37. Non-vegetarian food is not allowed in the school.
38. Except Father or Mother, no one is allowed to meet student or Principal in the School.
39. The Principal reserves to himself the right to dismiss from the school, any boy or girl whose conduct is, in his opinion, against the good moral tone of the school.
40. The school greatly requires the co-operation of parents from day to day and therefore they are requested to show constant interest in the progress of the children.
41. If any parent tries to use any recommendation or persons and bypass the school rules and regulations to get undue favour, the pupil will be dismissed immediately.

ABSENCE AND LEAVE

1. No leave of absence is granted except on previous written application from parents or guardians.
2. Absence without leave is liable for punishment either in form of fine or any other form at the Principal's discretion.
3. As a rule, no more than three day's leave of absence will be granted to attend the wedding of a brother or sister of either the boy or his parents. In case of more distant relatives, not more than one-day leave will be granted.
4. Leave of this nature is NEVER to be presumed. It is always to be obtained from the Principal only.
5. If any student is absent wilfully after his/her leave is being rejected, the students will be dismissed. Repeated absence for feast, weddings, etc. render the students liable to dismissal.
6. In case of an absence without leave, the boy/girl on returning to school must have the reason of absence entered and signed by parents or guardians in the Non-attendance and Leave Record in the school calendar.
7. A boy/girl returning to school after a contagious or infectious disease should also produce a Doctor's Certificate permitting him to sit in the class. Failure in producing such certificate, a boy/girl is obliged to return home during class hours.
8. Pupil must be present in the school on the last day before the holidays and the first day after holidays. If anyone remains absent, he/she will be suspended from the school. If absent for more than one day without the prior permission, he/she will be asked to discontinue.
9. All are expected to attend school on the reopening day after every vacation. Absent without previous leave (mere informing will not suffice) renders the pupils liable to being struck off the rolls.
10. Boys and girls who have been sent away from the school or have been struck off the rolls are not re-admitted.
11. Religious, sectional holidays will be allowed only on previous written application from the parents or guardians. Not more than one such holiday will be granted in the same month.
12. If a pupil is absent through illness for more than 3 days, the Principal must be informed at once.
13. If a student is absent without prior permission or any information for more than 15 days he/she is considered that he/she left the school.

RECOMMENDATION TO PARENTS

1. Parents or guardians are expected to co-operate with the school authorities by informing about their wards' regularity and discipline by observing their children or wards. They are advised to help children prepare their lessons by taking an active and helpful interest in the activities of the school. They are strongly recommended to attend the "Parents Teachers Meeting".
2. Parents or guardians are to understand that they cannot dictate to the management and management have a right to say on what condition they will admit or retain pupils in their school, provided such conditions are in conformity with the provision in the code and the instructions issued by the APPROPRIATE AUTHORITY from time to time.
3. If any parent tries to use any recommendation or persons and by pass the school rules and regulations to get undue favour, the pupil will be dismissed immediately.
4. Parents and guardians are especially requested to notify the school of any change in their address or telephone number. Please notify in written.
5. Parents, guardians or other persons are not allowed to see the pupil or interview their teachers during class time without the sanction of the Principal. As the staff should be seen preferably in their off periods and appointment with a member of the staff should be arranged beforehand. Any misbehaviour with staff will lead to your ward's dismissal.
6. Kindly abide by the decision of the Principal in matters of leave.
7. No meeting or discussion is allowed within the school premises without the Principal's permission.
8. The Principal can be met only in Office hours.
9. Parents are requested to consult the class/subject teachers to know about their wards progress.
10. Criticism of a teacher and the school in the presence of a student/ward should be strictly avoided because it causes the child to lose his/her respect for the teacher and the child may fail to learn from his/her mistakes. You should make a legitimate complaint to the principal.

11. When communicating with school authorities in writing, the parents are requested to mention the name, the standard and the section of their children.

ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWAL

1. No child less than three years of age and six years of age (by 31st March) is admitted to class LKG & Class I respectively. A corresponding scale is fixed for the succeeding standards.
2. A candidate who has attended any recognised school must bring a school leaving certificate from the school he/she has attended. If he/she comes from a school outside the state of Bihar, the Leaving Certificate must be counter signed by the Educational Officer of the state, in which the school is situated.
3. Notice of withdrawal should be given before the fifteenth of the month, else the fee for the following month will be charged. Such notice should be given by the person responsible for the pupil himself. Those who leave in April must pay their fee for May.
4. No leaving certificate will be granted unless school dues are paid in form of application, for the leaving certificate can be obtained from the school office, and it has to be signed by the person responsible for the pupil.

PROMOTIONS

1. For classes I - VII, the pupil has to secure 45 percent in each subject, in order to be promoted. For classes VIII - X, 50 percent is mandatory.
2. The year's record of work consists of the following; Two Periodic tests, Two Semester Exams & projects works.
3. Two - Periodic tests, half yearly exam and final exam for Classes VI - IX.
 - a. If a pupil is not able to appear for the whole or part of an examination; Re-examination will not be conducted.
 - b. 85% of attendance is required for promotion.
4. All cases of doubt regarding promotion are left entirely to the discretion of the principal and his decision shall be final.

FEE

1. Fees have to be deposited by 15th of every month. From 16th to 25th Rs. 10/- per day fine will be charged. If fee is not deposited by 25th of every month, the student will not be allowed in the school.
2. Fee for the month of June has to be deposited in advance in the month of May and respectively. No student will be allowed to appear for the final examination if the fee due is not cleared.
3. If the parents wish to deposit all the fee in advance they can do so.
4. The School Managing Committee reserves to itself the right to increase the rate of fees whenever it desires so.
